Held during April and May in Providence, Johnston, Smithfield, and North Providence, our Earth Month events are highly visible and well attended. More than 1,500 volunteers will join us to improve and beautify the Woonasquatucket River watershed. State and local officials will be on hand, and our strong relationships with local media and neighborhood organizations ensure robust event publicity and coverage. # **2024 EARTH MONTH EVENTS**

#### Friday, April 12, 10 am-2 pm: Providence

Join us to get Riverside Park ready for spring! We will be weeding, mulching, painting fences, and planting flowers. We will also remove debris left by winter storms.

#### Saturday, April 20, 10 am-2 pm: Johnston

Join us to beautify the part of the Woonasquatucket River Greenway that runs from Hillside Avenue to Manton Pond in Johnston. Volunteers will plant flowers, clear litter, remove invasives, spread mulch, and put on waders and get into canoes for in-water cleanups.

### Monday, April 22 (Earth Day!), 10 am-2 pm: Providence

On Earth Day, we're cleaning the Woonasquatucket River and surrounding land along Promenade and Kinsley Streets in Providence. We will be putting on waders and getting in boats for in-water cleanups, painting guard rails and benches, and planting trees.

### Saturday, May 4, 10 am-2 pm: Smithfield

Join us for the official ribbon-cutting at the Leo Bouchard Conservation Center in Smithfield. In addition to celebrating this joint venture of the WRWC and the Town of Smithfield, we will be cleaning in and around Stillwater Reservoir, planting flowers, and more. We will be offering canoe rides, too!

### Saturday, May 11, 10 am-2 pm: North Providence

In collaboration with the Rhode Island Tree Council, we will be planting trees at the newly developed Adams Lane river access location, along with maintaining trails, removing invasive plants, and collecting trash. We will also be working on Cricket Field beautification and doing an in-water clean up at Greystone Pond.

In addition to Earth Month events, we schedule 20+ volunteer days throughout the year individuals and small teams welcome. We also offer custom group volunteer opportunities for corporate or community groups.
