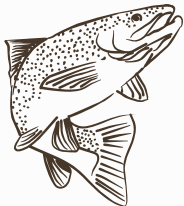

THE EVENT

THE IMPACT

For 24 years, the Woonasquatucket River Watershed Council has led environmental restoration and climate resilience efforts in Rhode Island. We partner with riverfront communities to reduce flood risks, provide environmental education, create recreation opportunities, and support local climate leaders. 2025's Earth Day Celebration launches a year of volunteer events. Sponsorships fund the Woonasquatucket River Rangers, who keep the Greenway safe, clean, and green, and supply essential tools, trees, and plants for this large-scale effort.

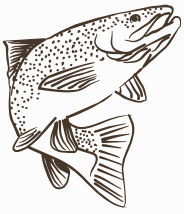
THE IMPACT
